**TODAY'S GAME:** Finale of a four-game series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers (DET) at Spectrum Field (3-0)...Clearwater is coming off a six-game road trip in which it took all three games against the St. Lucie Mets (NYM) at First Data Field, but dropped all three contests against the Charlotte Stone Crabs (TB) at Charlotte Sports Park...Fourth, and final series (15 games) between the two clubs in 2019...Clearwater took three out of four against the Detroit Tigers affiliate at home back on May 13-16.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** 20-year-old Kyle Glogoski makes his 12th start at the Advanced-A level in the finale of the four-game series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on Thursday night at Spectrum Field...The 6-foot-1 hurler suffered the loss on Aug. 23 against the Charlotte Stone Crabs...The right-hander allowed only two runs on four hits, two walks and four strikeouts across five innings of work...Thursday will be the New Zealand native's first career start against the Detroit Tigers affiliate.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Clearwater Threshers extended their winning streak to three games with a 5-1 victory over the Lakeland Flying Tigers at Spectrum Field on Wednesday night...James McArthur earned his third win of the season with just one run allowed over seven frames...Matt Kroon and Jhailyn Ortiz sent out souvenirs with solo home runs...Daniel Brito broke a 1-1 tie with an RBI double in the fifth...Keylan Killgore earned his 10th save of the season with two scoreless innings of relief.

**WHALIN' JHAYLIN:** Jhailyn Ortiz has been a run-producing machine through the first three games of the series against Lakeland...The 20-year-old has collected five RBIs since Monday with two in game one, one in game two and two on Wednesday night...The barrage is the most for Ortiz since pushing across five runners against the Palm Beach Cardinals from July 9-11.

**GETTING OFFENSIVE:** With another five-run performance on Wednesday night, the Threshers have scored exactly five runs in each of the first three games of the series against the Flying Tigers...Clearwater's offense has collected 29 hits over the three contests, including nine doubles and two homers...This offensive eruption comes after scoring no runs over the previous three matchups against the Charlotte Stone Crabs over the weekend, with only 11 hits (none for extra-bases).

**START ME UP:** James McArthur finished his 2019 campaign on a tear on the mound, winning each of his final three starts of the season...The Mississippi product has allowed only one run over his past 17.2 innings, scattering 13 hits, walking four and striking out 16...Since Aug. 18, Clearwater's full-time starters (including Andrew Brown's six innings of relief on Monday) have allowed only 11 earned runs (16 total) over 54.2 innings of work (1.83 ERA).

**QUIET THE SHOCKER:** Keylan Killgore walked two batters in the eighth inning, but worked around trouble en route to his 10th save of the season...The southpaw leads the league in the category, and has piled them up in 11 chances...The Wichita State product has rebounded significantly during the final month of the season, posting a 2.70 ERA (4er/13.1ip) in eight appearances after putting up a 9.00 ERA through nine games in July.

**PLAYING SOME FALL BALL:** The 2019 Arizona Fall League rosters were announced on Aug. 28, and three members of the Scottsdale Scorpions played for the Clearwater Threshers for the majority of the season...RHP Spencer Howard will be joined by infielders Alec Bohm and Nick Maton...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen will join the former Threshers in the same position with the Scorpions...The league begins Sept. 18.

**CRUNCH TIME:** With the regular season down to its final day, the Clearwater Threshers find themselves in the playoff hunt...The division title is out of reach for the Philadelphia Phillies affiliate, as they were eliminated with Sunday's loss to the Stone Crabs, but a shot at the Wild Card is still possible...Clearwater comes into Wednesday tied with the Daytona Tortugas (CIN) for the top-spot, but hold the head-to-head tie breaker by going 8-4 against the Cincinnati Reds affiliate during the season.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY:** Thursday is Threshers' Catcher Nick Matera's birthday!...He turns 23 years-old.
